

12. Clickemin Farmhouse



Clickemin Farmhouse is located on the north side of the A696 just to the east of the former Clickemin Farm buildings. As with the Eland Green farmhouse, this dwelling is typical of many 19th Century farmhouses; the construction materials are brick and slate, with stone architraves, mullions and lintels; there is a stone string course along the line of the lower lintel of the 1st floor windows, and stone porch is surmounted by a pitched roof. At some later stage, most probably in the 20th Century, the farmhouse was extended on two floors to the rear which virtually doubled the total floor area.

During 2015/16 the house was subject to several further alterations, providing a wider entrance to the property from the road and adding a separate garage and rear extensions which included a number of full-length windows in the modern fashion. The front elevation does, however, appear little changed although a garage in front of the Building Line has recently been granted planning permission.
