

15. No. 8 Darras Road.



This property was built for Miss Wakinshaw's gardener at the same time as No. 10. It, also, is of a brick and tile construction but has a quite distinctive form and appearance, being of one storey and completely square in plan, with a pyramid roof surmounted at the apex by a single chimney stack incorporating four separate flues. In terms of both historical and architectural significance, the two dwellings should be considered together.

As with No.10, a detached garage in similar style has been added to the property in the 20th Century.
